In town water - \$70.53 bi-monthly at 6,000 gallon minimum; \$6.98 excess rate per 1,000 gallons. Out of town water - \$141.06 bi-monthly at 6,000 gallon minimum; \$10.81 excess rate per 1,000 gallons.

Out of town sewer - \$89.48 bi-monthly at 6,000 gallon minimum; \$9.60 excess rate per 1,000 gallons.
